We have received notification via Richard Cooper (following on from Stephen Culpin who organised the Bid) that DEFRA have put our Bid (and 26 others) out to public consultation.

The 27 bids out for consultation include 14 for river locations, including our friends from Wetherby.

In terms of numbers of bathers our average of 276 bathers on the two occasions submitted exceeds all other river locations apart from the river Cam and the River Dart (2 locations) Surely that counts for something?
