Courtesy of The Guardian and Feargal Sharkey, I found this <u>link</u> very helpful in summarising the Storm Overflows of Sewage (EDM data) into our rivers.

Putting in a postcode gives you your local rivers (in my case Wharfe, Nidd and Ure) You get a map showing the individual discharge points and the volumes sent into our rivers.

Each of my three rivers had more than 2000 sewage spells last year, with the Nidd having more sewage spells per mile than the other two rivers.

All disgraceful behaviour by Yorkshire Water, and 'it was a wet winter' just doesn't cut it as an excuse.

Let's have substantial effective investment ASAP to make this problem something to be ashamed of in the past.
